The deadline for voting is 12 noon on Wednesday 2 July 2025. The results will be published on Thursday 3 July 2025.

To be valid this form of proxy together with the authority (if any) under which it is signed or a duly certified copy thereof (or if such power or authority was executed outside the United Kingdom a notarially authenticated copy thereof) must be lodged at the Society's registered office at 25a Bell Street, Henley-on-Thames RG9 2BA no later than 12 noon on Wednesday 2 July 2025.
- 4. Alternatively you can sign the form and return a scanned copy of the signed document by email addressed to office1@oss.org.uk by **12 noon on Wednesday 2 July 2025.**
- 5. Any alterations to this form should be initialled.
